BOURTON WOOD PERMIT

1. Permits to walk in Bourton Wood are available from the Estate Office by return of the 'tear off' section of this form.

The Estate Office is open for permits on a Monday - Thursday each week, between 9am – 2pm.

2. The permits are valid for 12 months from the date of issue and are not transferrable.

3. Permits are issued for quiet enjoyment and recreation. To this end the following rules are in place:

- No Motorised Vehicles
- No Bicycles
- No Horses
- No Picking/Uprooting/Catching/Collecting of plants/animals
- No Lighting of Fires
- No Carrying or Use of Weapons of Any Sort

4. This is a commercial woodland therefore please be aware at all times of forestry operations, working machinery, lorries and other activities.

5. There will be occasions when areas of the wood are closed to public access. For safety reasons, please adhere to these restrictions.

6. Children must be accompanied by an adult.

7. Dogs must be kept on a lead.

8. A charge of £20 is made for the issue of a permit. Applications must be made on the form below which should be returned to the Estate Office, Batsford.

In applying for a permit to walk in Bourton Wood, I undertake to abide by the conditions stated above. In particular, I agree that the owners shall not be liable to me or any person accompanying me for any injury, damage or loss of whatever kind and however caused, sustained or suffered whilst in Bourton Wood. I further agree that the owners may at any time, at their discretion, withdraw the permit or vary the conditions attached to it. I enclose a cheque or cash, to Batsford Estate, for the sum of £20
